EDUCATION PROGRAMME:

The bliss of making a child educated is more than any help that one can provide in this world. Guru Daani Foundation is working with this theme as one of the prominent NGO



in India in educating the young children especially the girl population of the Indian society, so that the coming generations would have the right knowledge and degree to serve with their bright future. Guru Daani Foundation is organizing various nation building

campaign and above the line, proper consultation and counseling is provided to parents in weaker sections of society.

Education is necessary for every child in order for society and communities to develop. Recently the Indian Government instated a law making it necessary for every child to get an education, but many children leave school so there is a need for assistance in the schools located in rural and remote areas.

Education is one of the areas that are on top of our agenda. During the year under review we put considerable emphasis on providing quality education to children of all communities – especially those belonging to underprivileged, SC/ ST communities and weaker section of the society where educational facilities are most inadequate.

We organized literacy- training campus in 2019-2020 in rural areas for creating awareness about the importance of education. We distributed books and stationery to the children. We motivated their parents to ensure that their children – especially the girl children – study in schools.

FOOD DISTRIBUTION TO NEEDY PEOPLE:



As you know how the corona virus pandemic has spread in this world, there is a lot of destruction in our country in all sectors. Because of this, some people were not getting food for their

families. with a small effort in this situation, Guru Danni team and their team of social workers distributed food to 300 to 400 people in collaboration with volunteer on weekdays.

We all wish we could do more to support underprivileged serious patients facing challenges and their caregivers, beyond our prayers. Sometimes, the family members of serious patients do not have time to look after themselves, not even have the time to have food, which is the basic necessity as they are always around taking care of their closed ones. Majority of the underprivileged patients admitted in Government hospitals

are those who come from nearby states are often poor, in several cases family members decide to stay hungry to save money. Guru Daani Foundation serve free, but wholesome, food to families of underprivileged patients in the Govt. Hospital and also for the children who come from a far-off places to the Delhi hospitals for often longer treatments. You can also join our team during food distribution drive.

TREE PLANTATION:

Guru Daani Foundation has worked to solve two persistent problems: unemployment and the devastation of the urban tree canopy. To solve these pressing issues, we help promising young people build sustainable careers and plant trees for a resilient and healthy planet. We provide career training because we think people deserve the opportunity to build meaningful careers. We plant trees because we believe a vibrant urban tree canopy is essential to a healthy planet.



The team started the tree plantation drive by pledging with deep sincerity to always plant more trees and also nurture them followed by dedicatedly planting the saplings in pits that were dug prior to the plantation drive. Although, the initiative required dedicated efforts, the final result left the volunteers with a sense of accomplishment and a feeling of gratitude towards mother nature.

HEALTH CARE PROGRAMME:

In order to enhance public health among the poor and marginalized, strengthening systems within the health sector is critical. The primary focus of Guru Daani Foundation is to run free health check-up camps to provide healthcare opportunities to the underprivileged and to ensure that the underserved have access to a quality healthcare facility. The majority of our patients are the very poor coming from labouring and



farming families. Guru Daani Foundation offers free consultations, free check-ups and free medicines to the very poor and underprivileged. We are regularly joined in the free medical-camps by volunteer doctors who bring with them valuable new knowledge and extra pairs of hands in the process of improving health status, Guru Daani Foundation has adopted the following methods:

- Free health check-up camps.
- Free distribution of medicines.
- Life stream Blood Bank.
- Free Health camps to disseminate health education.
- Free distribution of blankets & clothes.
- Health camps to detect the common diseases and provide them referral services.

We have organized about 20 free camps at various slums and villages on the outskirts of Delhi and National Capital Region over the past few years. We have empanelled qualified MBBS, MD with our team. These camps have proved to be extremely beneficial for the people in the slums. On an average, we treat about 40-60 patients in our every camp. We provide free medicines, free consultations and counseling besides discounted diagnostics with various health centers.

MASK & FOOD DISTRIBUTION

The corona virus has proven itself to be a highly communicable disease, so people were instructed to stay at home at all times. Because of the communicable nature of this virus, there was a sudden and huge requirement of masks and gloves. People started to wear masks so that, if they are infected, they do not infect the other person and it also protects them from getting infected from others. Studies state that, if a normal person comes in contact with an asymptomatic COVID-19 patient and both are wearing masks, the probability of the non-affected person getting the virus is exceptionally low compared to other situations. This eventually spiked the demand for masks and a lot of people including mask manufacturers and



NGO volunteers came together to serve the country. Divyangs also came forward and provided valuable help in making masks available to the normal public. They also helped us in Corona Relief Seva in preparing food that helps our volunteers in Free Food Distribution during the lockdown. The origin of help should always be the love at the bottom of your heart and empathy that you feel towards the person you are helping. Then only will your act of help be of divine importance. Our Divyangs have shown what humanity truly means. They provided Free Masks and Free food to the hungry and poor to keep everyone safe.
